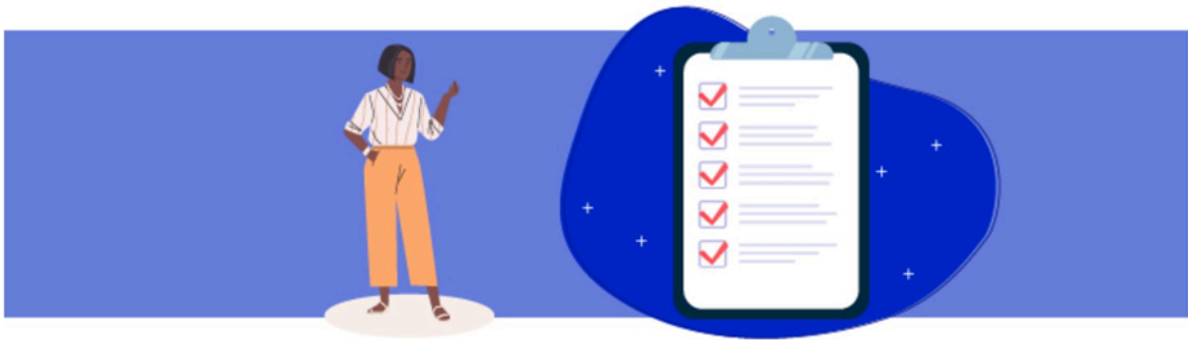


## Install and Configure Windows 11

### P1C4 : Perform the Basic Configurations

Reminder of the instructions

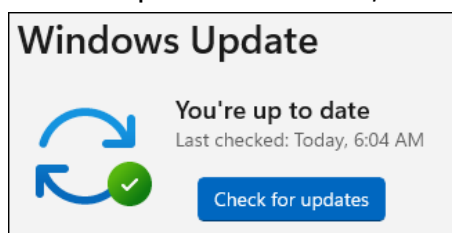
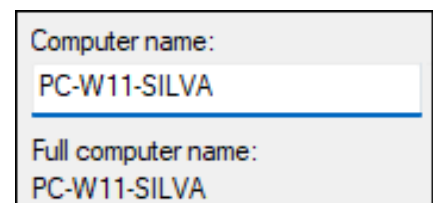
You previously installed Windows 11 on a virtual machine at your manager's request. Before handing the machine over, you need to complete a few basic configurations.

On your manager's virtual machine, perform the following configurations:

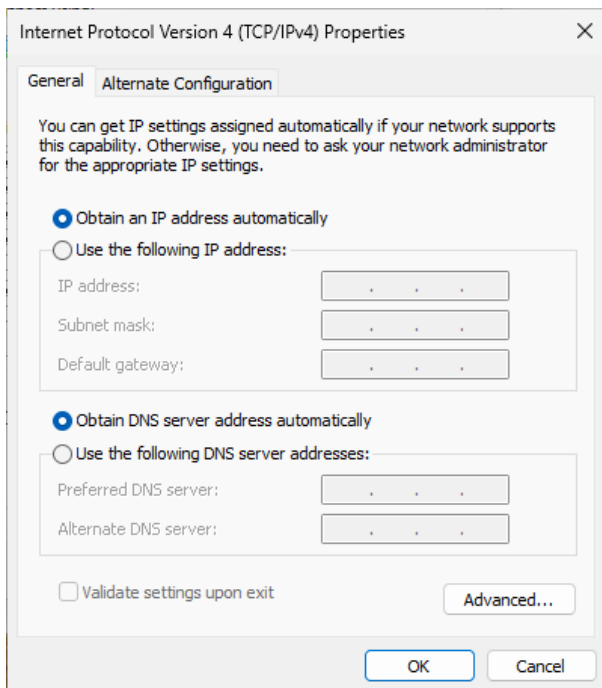
- Rename the computer "PC-W11-SILVA".
- Verify that the network adapter is configured automatically (DHCP).
- Install all available updates.
- Add a second 10 GB disk to the virtual machine for data storage and make it accessible in File Explorer as drive F.

Proposed answer

To **rename** the computer, go to Settings > System > About > Rename this PC, or run "sysdm.cpl", open the Computer Name tab, and click Change.



**Operating system** updates are managed through Settings > Windows Update, or by running "control update".



To **configure the network card for DHCP**, go to Settings > Network & internet > Advanced network settings > Expand the section related to the network adapter > Edit button in More adapter options section or run "ncpa.cpl" > Internet Protocol Version 4 Properties de and et check the options Obtain an IP address automatically and Obtain DNS server addresses automatically.

After adding a second 10-GB hard drive to your manager's VM, go to **Disk Management** by right-clicking the Start menu or run "diskmgmt.msc".

Initialize Disk 1, then create a new volume using the unallocated space and assign it the letter F. The volume must appear as drive F in File Explorer.
